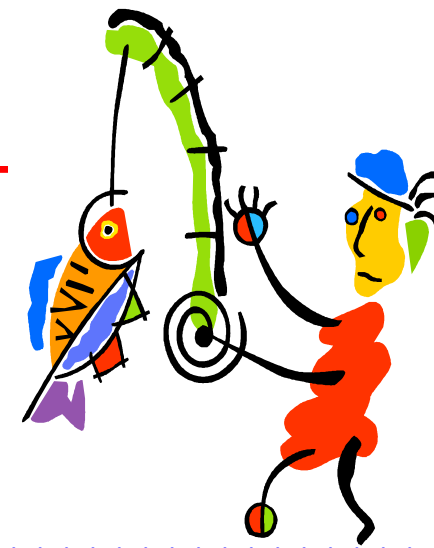
Come join us in our "Fishing for Funds" Fundraiser!!!

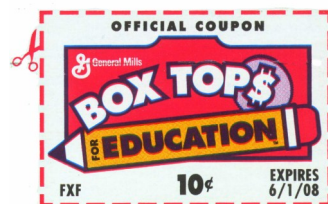
UCA's own 9th grader Holden Dixon!
